LTC Provisional Lead Committee

1. All leadership candidates are subject to approval by the LTC Chair, Vice Chair, and technical chairs prior to submission for certification by the Safety Committee. Completion of check-offs, provisionals, tests, and the taking of required courses are not an indication of automatic submission for certification to the Safety Committee. Becoming an Angeles Chapter leader is a privilege, not a right. Our leaders bear great responsibilities, and the passing of a check-off or the completion of a class is only a part of leadership training. The LTC reserves the right not to approve a potential leader if it deems that the leader candidate lacks sufficient leadership qualities. These include, but are not be limited to, judgment, character, and the ability to work with people.
2. Recognizing the special needs of M and E leaders entering the provisional stage of leadership training, the LTC formed a Provisional Lead Committee in March 2001. The purpose of this committee is to approve M and E candidates for provisional leads and on completion of those leads to approve their presentation to the Safety Committee for leader certification.
3. The LTC Provisional Lead Committee is made up of:
 - The LTC Chair
 - The LTC Vice Chair
 - The LTC Rock Chair
 - The LTC Snow Chair
 - The LTC Navigation Co-chairs
4. All prospective M and E leaders must present the committee with a Snow and Rock climbing resume current with climbs completed in the last three years. The climbs listed must be M and E climbs that would be typically led by the SPS in the Sierra Nevada or their equivalent. The committee will approve or disapprove the potential leader to lead provisional trips based on what it considers sufficient experience in the kinds of trips that Angeles Chapter M and E leaders typically lead.
5. It is the responsibility of the potential leader to submit his or her resume to either the LTC Chair or Vice Chair preferably in the form of an email. The committee will inform the candidate promptly whether he or she may proceed to the provisional stage or must first gain more experience.
6. M and E Leaders completing their provisionals will be approved by the Provisional Lead Committee for submission to the Safety Committee for certification or asked to lead additional provisionals.
