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AN ONOFRE STATE PARK is located on the property of the Camp Pendleton Marine Corps Base. The Park was granted a 50-year Lease for the San Onofre State Park in 1971 and is set to expire in 2021.

The State Park Foundation, the San Onofre State Parks Foundation, and the California State Parks have been working for the past couple of years on getting a new lease to allow the park to remain open and for public use of the beach, campgrounds and back country hiking and biking trails.

The San Onofre State Park Foundation has issued a Press Release on April 25, 2020 advising us that the Department of the Navy and the Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton support a 3-year extension to allow time to complete a new 50-year extension. This is a major step in the process.
